## **ClubFife Activity Provider Questionnaire**

All clubs should complete the questionnaire below and evidence any documents requested.

**Levels** There are 2 levels of ClubFife



Activity provider ensures that the club meets a minimum set of requirements. This includes basic structure, insurance and qualifications.



Sports Clubs should strive to achieve ClubFife Gold Star status. This supports the club to look at their governance, procedures and development. Only clubs who have achieved Gold Star status will be able to access the benefits of the ClubFife programme.

### **Step by Step Guide**

Is the process that all clubs will go through to achieve ClubFife

#### **STEP 1 Submission**

Complete and return the ClubFife application form



#### **STEP 2 Review**

A member of the sports development team will review the evidence submitted and will inform the club if all the essential evidence has been received.



#### **ACCREDITATION COMPLETE**

Congratulations. Your club has successfully completed the ClubFife Activity Provider accreditation process.



#### **ACCREDITATION INCOMPLETE**

A member of the Sports Development team will be in touch to arrange a meeting to discuss the reasons why the accreditation criteria has not currently been met, along with advice and support to help the club successfully achieve accreditation.



#### **STEP 6 Accreditation**

ClubFife is valid for 3 years and to regain ClubFife accreditation a club is reassessed on all areas.

During the 3 year accreditation period, you should expect at least one visit from a member of the Sports Development team.



#### **STEP 6 Gold Star Accreditation**

Your club will be provided information on the Gold Star Accreditation process which is the next level of ClubFife accreditation.
